Emergency help that was sent by St. Francis was a lifeline for many. Many families expressed their defeat, feeling forgotten and helpless. Knowing that we remember them gives them hope. Concern remains going forward as the Haitian families face food insecurity. We will continue to work with Father for the good of the community and will keep you updated. We have exciting news that 100% of the 9th grade class passed the national examinations!! The school year for 2019-20 ended on November 6 and the first day of school for the 2020-21 year was on November 16th! We have a growing attendance and dedicated teachers. Fr. Augustin and the parents built a temporary area for the added classes this year. Even with the 3 months of school closure, due to the dedication of the teachers, the students had their work delivered so disruption was as minimal as possible. Thank you for your support and prayers for them! Even with the increased costs of food, we have been able to continue to feed the students each day.
