Prayer

As a committee, prayer is our number one priority. Members commit to weekly private prayer. Whether it be through a holy hour, fasting one day per week, or simply lifting up the Respect Life intentions for each day, we are committed as parishioners to lift the Culture of Life up to the Lord daily and beg for His will to be done. Outreach

Since 2009, our main avenue of outreach has been the St. Francis lay apostolate known as Mary's House. Mary's House is an outreach of the St. Francis parish family to pregnant women in our community who come to us with physical, spiritual and financial needs. We offer peer counseling, baby supplies, maternity clothes, temporary housing and material assistance, transportation and a mentoring program with experienced mothers in the parish. The Respect Life committee has conducted Adult Ed and CCD classes in order to inform members of the parish of various Culture of Life issues.
