On January 21, 2015, 34 of St. Francis' youth and 3 adult chaperones traveled to Washington, D.C. to attend the 41st annual March for Life. Traveling by bus with youth from St. Patrick's, Lexington, the students met thousands of youth from across the nation at an evening of prayer at the Patriot Center stadium at George Mason University. The Evening of prayer sponsored by the Diocese of Arlington, featured several high energy musical performances, prayer, reflections, and Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament.

After a short sleep in a Fairfax hotel, students returned to a packed Patriot Center for a Mass and the Life is Very Good youth rally, also sponsored by the Diocese of Arlington. A Chick-Fil-A lunch was provided for over 5,000 as people proceeded in buses to the Washington Mall for the March.

As a result of fundraising efforts in the fall, the St. Francis Youth for Life were able to cover the full cost of the pilgrimage for all members, as well as provide half-price scholarships for any other parishioners who wished to attend.
