## October 7 Respect Life Sunday Year of Faith begins October 11

Forty years ago the Catholic bishops in the United States designated October as Respect Life Month, and named the first Sunday of October as "Respect Life Sunday." Throughout October, Catholics are called in a special way to reflect on the gift of human life, the threats against it and how we can protect all persons from conception to natural death. Providentially, Pope Benedict XVI has declared a worldwide Year of Faith, beginning on October 11, 2012 and concluding on November 24, 2013. The Holy See calls each of us in this Year of Faith to study the teachings of the Church and to strengthen our personal relationship with our Lord. The fortieth anniversary of Roe v. Wade lands squarely within the Year of Faith. It is as if the Holy Father has given the Church in the United States a focused time to acknowledge the great sin of abortion, and to embrace a time of penance and conversion. Above all, in this Respect Life Month and throughout the Year of Faith, may our parish and all its members become living witnesses to God's longing to forgive and to pour out his healing mercy upon all those who have promoted or been wounded by the culture of death.
